2007 Curriculum

Goal Oriented Actions with The Ball & Learning to Play Together

The 2007 Age group is in **Stage 1 of Development** which is described as **Mastery of the Ball (Skills) and Dominating the 1v1**. The main emphasis will be when "we" have the ball (offense). There will be little emphasis on coaching when "they" have the ball (defense) with the main goal being to get the ball back. Teams play in 7 v 7 format.

The main objective within the curriculum is to develop soccer personalities while having players emulate their favorite players. We will challenge each player to develop skill by playing with the ball as much as they can.

Technique: Teach and develop juggling, dribbling, running with the ball , 1vs1 attacking, short passing, and scoring with both sides of the body.

Insight: Teach 1vs1 offense and a basic understanding of roles and positions. Strategy and tactics will be based on the individual and very basic in both "we" have the ball (offense) and "they" have the ball (defense).

BUSC Internal Camp

BUSC provides the age group a 4-day, Monday-Thursday, 90 minute summer camp experience. We have partnered with Franz Hoek, the current assistant coach at Manchester United, who provides professional Dutch coaches to participate in our club camps.

Top Player Program (TPP)

The club prides itself on individual player development. The coaches and technical staff will collectively decide on players within each team that the staff feels needs a higher training environment to accelerate their development. This usually takes the form of training weekly with a higher-level team or age group and periodically guest playing in games.

Video Program

The club excited to add game/training video analysis to our curriculum. Each team will have 2-3 games filmed and the team will use the clubs education-training center to view and review the game or training footage.
